Our unique camp encourages maximum creativity. Half of the day, campers develop a play. Campers decide what character they want to be, and collaborate to write a play including all the characters. Astronaut, rock star, tiger, doctor?— anyone you imagine can be in the play (except no copyrighted characters or real people). All characters get equal numbers of lines and stage time.

The other half of the day, campers work on visual arts—designing and creating sets, props, and costumes; painting self-portraits; drawing; and other artistic activities. Some artwork can be taken home. Campers will also have time outdoors.

Campers perform the play for families and friends on the last day of camp, Friday, July 22, at 3 pm.
